TEST (Thoracic European Surgical Trials) is a European surgical clinical trials platform promoting clinical trial enrollment and execution in surgical centers across Europe. Currently more than 20 academic and non-academic large volume thoracic surgery centers are part of this platform. We wish to connect the expertise generated via the Early-stage Lung cancer International eXpert Retreat with transcontinental clinical trial development.

We are planning a multi-disciplinary KOL TEST session to develop innovative trials, novel treatment strategies, enrollment optimization, and cutting-edge translational research opportunities that will shape the next wave of surgical advancements in lung cancer care. - Day 1: Working groups for Stage I, II, III, IV NSCLC, perioperative care and pathways to ensure adherence to intended oncologic therapy, translational research opportunities.
- Day 2: Presentation of suggestions and vote for three projects to move forward.
